# The Entertainer - Scott Joplin RONDO FORM (individual or partner collaboration)

- Explore, demonstrate general functions on Songmaker ("measures")
- Settings = Length 16
- Recommended tempo setting 50 (students can modify as they create)
- Establish Percussion beats at bottom of page
- Establish pitches at top of page (corresponds to boomwhacker colors, pitches)
- Revise, modify
- Save
- Share

# The Entertainer by Scott Joplin RONDO Movement Piece

4.ML.2.1– [Interpret rhythm patterns, including whole, half, dotted half, quarter, and eighth notes and rests in 2/4, 3/4, and 4/4 meter signatures.]

**OBJECTIVE:** Students will reinforce their knowledge of Rondo form and will collaborate in groups to create movement for the different themes of rondo form in *The Entertainer* by Scott Joplin.



### **Rondo Movement Piece**

- Students reflect on the music from The Entertainer by Scott Joplin.
- What emotion do they feel as they listen to it? Why?
- Invite a student or students to the whiteboard to write the parts of the Rondo form what they remember from a previous activity based on rondo form.
- Students will create movement piece for some sections of the rondo form
- Students learn A section. The movement from the Introduction from the Body/Percussion movement can be used for the Intro here.
- Students learn A moves.
- Students break into various groups and create their own moves for one of the sections of the rondo form. (modify amount of sections you do if needed)
